**Other Foundation News**

The Board received reports on the Foundation assets at December 31, 2017. Foundation net assets at December 31, 2017, were \$372,724,000. The timber investment was valued at \$159,404,000, at December 31, 2017. The marketable equity securities were valued at \$136,836,000. Management and general expenses were 0.56% of net assets, annualized, well below the national average of 1-1.5%.

The Foundation Board elected the following officers for a two-year term through March 31, 2020: Mr. John McMillan, President; Mr. Robert Word, Vice President; Mr. Lowell Bonds, Secretary; and Dr. Jeanne Sylvestre, Treasurer.

Dr. Elizabeth VandeWaa, a Board member and President of the USA Faculty Senate, provided a review of the work of the Faculty Senate over the past year.

Dr. Harold Pardue, Dean of the Graduate School and Associate Vice President, Academic Affairs, reported on the USA Foundation Research Fellowship programs. Two graduate Foundation Research Fellows spoke of their research and experiences in the programs.
