

\$13,216,100 GIVEN IN FISCAL YEAR 2023 BY USA FOUNDATION TO UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH ALABAMA

The USA Foundation Board, at its June 1st meeting, approved **\$6,259,680** as the semi-annual contribution to the University, bringing the total contribution for the fiscal year 2023 to **\$13,216,100**.

Contributions for fiscal year 2023 include:

- \$1,208,380 for scholarships;
- \$3,002,625 for faculty support, including 36 professorships; and
- \$9,005,095 for academic programs, including \$7,791,850 supporting the USA Health system.

CURRENT FOUNDATION NEWS

The USA Foundation at March 31, 2023:

- Foundation net assets were \$400,143,000.
- Marketable securities (stocks) were valued at \$209,658,000.
- Timber investment was valued at \$173,590,000.
- Other investments and assets were valued at \$16,895,000.
- Management and general expenses were 0.68% of net assets.
